Bhí cruinniú poiblí in Ionad Áise Réidh na nDoirí,
Gaeltacht Mhúscraí ar an gCéadaoin, 10ú Feabhra, 2010.

An cúis a bhí leis an gcruinniú ná chun todhchaí MFG Meitheal Mhúscraí a phlé i dtéarmaí an obair atá á dhéanamh, agus an obair atá á phleanáil faoin gclár tosnaithe i 2010, an Clár Forbartha Áitiúil agus Pobail, chomh maith le h-obair eile leanúnach atá á dhéanamh ag an grúpa. Bhí slua maith ag an gcruinniú, le thart ar 50 daoine i láthair. Bhí Máire Uí Laoire mar chathaoirleach, chur sí fáilte roimh gach éinne, agus dhein sí cur síos ar chúis agus leagan amach an gcruinniú, na príomh rudaí a bhí le plé agus na rudaí nach raibh le plé - sé sin cuma na mbóithre, cúrsaí pleanáil tithe agus rl.

Chur Anne Labrosse, comh-ordaitheoir, tuilleadh eolais ar fáil ar formáid an gcruinniú. Deineadh cur síos ar staid an obair faoi láthair, gearrthaí siar san aireamh mar an gcéanna le n-alán cláir agus seirbhísí le maoiniú ón Rialtais. Ar nóta dearfach, dúradh go raibh an Ionad Aise fós oscailte cúig lá sa tseachtain, agus ar fáil ag an deireadh seachtaine agus seacht tráthnóna sa tseachtain má's gá, maoinithe don gcuid is mó tré cláracha ón Roinn Gnóthaí Pobail Tuaithe agus Gaeltachta.

Bhí cur síos ar an obair atá idir lámh agus ar spriocanna an clár nua. Tugadh deis do gach éinne na seirbhísí atá ar fáil faoi láthair a rátáil, 'sé sin dá mba chóir dos na seirbhísí **Fanúint** mar atá nó a **Stopadh**. Lorgaíodh tuairimí ar an obair atá ar siúl faoi láthair. Lorgaíodh tuairimí chomh maith ós na daoine i láthair maidir le spriocanna an clár nua; bearnaí sna seirbhísí; saincheist tabhachtacha eile; agus modhanna chun teacht ar na saincheist sin.

Bhí eolas níos mion ar na bhallaí maidir leis an obair idir lámh faoi láthair agus ar spriocanna an Clár nua Forbartha Áitiúil agus Pobail chun deis a thabhairt do dhaoine é a fheiscint agus ionchur a bheith acu air. Bhí sé seo curtha ar fáil chuig gach éinne chun é a thabhairt abhaile leo, chun é a scaipeadh agus chun macnamh a dhéanamh air. Bhí cuireadh curtha roimh gach éinne ais-eolas a chur ar aghaidh chuig MFG-Meitheal Mhúscraí nuair a bhí seans acu tuilleadh staidéar a dhéanamh ar an t-eolas. (Féach lch 17 & 18) Tar éis an ionchur seo ós na rannpháirtithe, bhí plé gairid ar na gnéithe comónta gur ba chóir tuilleadh scrúdú a dhéanamh orthu. (Féach lch 11 - 14)

Tá torthaí an comhairliúcháin seo leagtha amach ar an taobh eile don leathanach, chomh maith le ais-eolas agus tuairimí na rannpháirtithe ar an oíche agus san am tar éis an gcruinniú. (Clár Iniatacht Sóisialta = Leathanach 3-4 : Clár Seirbhísí Pobail = Leathanach 5-6)

A Public Meeting was held in the Ionad Áise in Réidh na nDoirí, Gaeltacht Mhúscraí on Wednesday, 10th February, 2010.



The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the future of MFG-Meitheal Mhúscraí in terms of the work being done, and that planned under the program started in 2010, the Local and Community Development Program, as well as the other work ongoing by the group. The meeting was well attended, with almost 50 people in attendance. The meeting was chaired by Máire Uí Laoire, who welcomed everybody, and introduced the purpose of the meeting, and the suggested format, including main topics to be covered and those which would not be discussed - ie. condition of the roads, planning permission, etc.

Anne Labrosse, the co-ordinator, then gave some more detail about the proposed format for the evening. The situation of the work currently was outlined, including the fact that there had been necessary cutbacks - in common with most other programs and services funded by Government. On a positive note, those in attendance were told that the Ionad Áise remains open, and though there have been cutbacks, the office is manned 5 days per week; is open 7 nights per week, and at weekends as required - with funding available under various programs from the Dept. of Community Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs.

The work currently in train was described briefly, and the new program Goals were introduced. Those in attendance were asked to rate the services currently in place, ie. whether these services should **Continue** or **Discontinue**. They were also asked for comments on the work being done currently in the Ionad Áise. Participants were also asked to input with regard to the new program goals; identify gaps in services; issues of importance; methods that could be used to address those issues.

More detailed information on both the work currently being done, and the new Local & Community Development Program Goals were available on the walls of the Ionad Áise for people to see and to give their input. This information was also distributed to all in attendance to take away, to think about and share with others. Participants were invited to to send feedback to MFG-Meitheal Mhúscraí when they had had a chance to examine and analyse that information further (see pages 17 & 18) Following the input by participants, there was a brief discussion on common threads / issues of importance which should be explored further (see pages 11 - 14)

Results of this consultation are set out overleaf, as well as feedback and comments from the participants on that night and in the time following that meeting.
